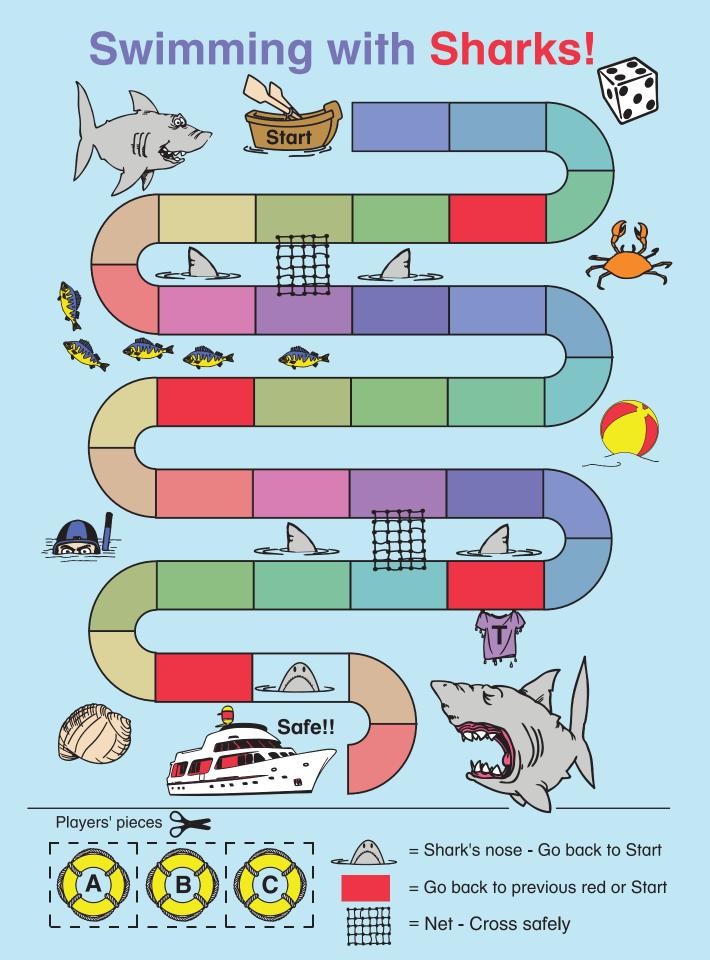

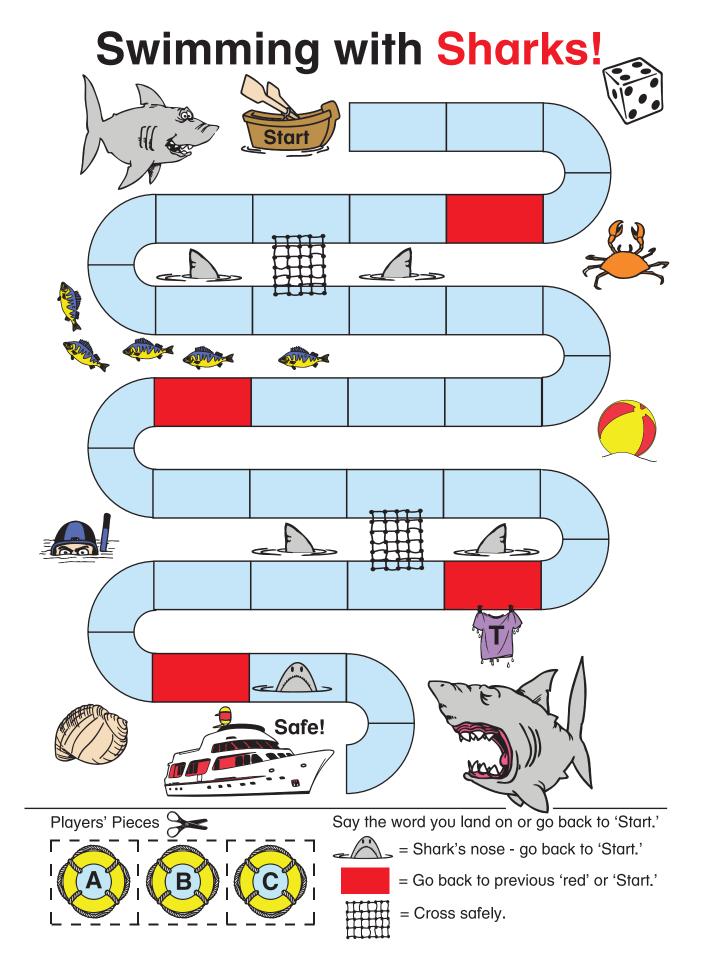

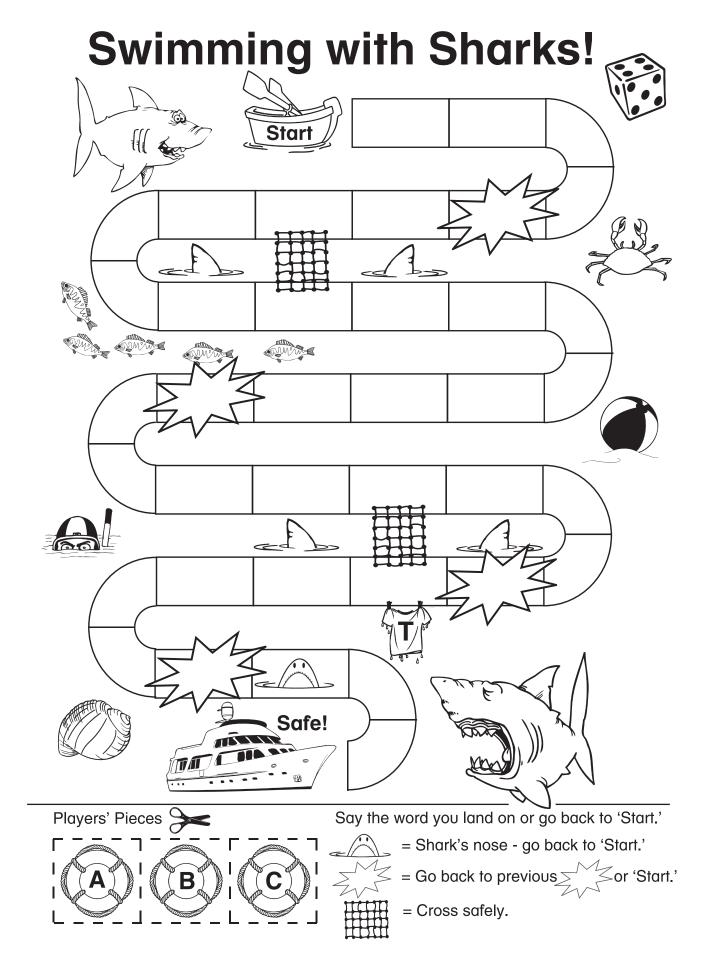

**Swimming with Sharks! Instructions -** A game for 2-4 players. This is a blank version of the game that teachers can modify to suit the lessons being taught. It is recommended to fill the blank spaces with words or images as in the phonics lesson below.

Each player throws one or gwo dice and, counting aloud in English, moves her counter or button.

When a player lands on a Red or space in the black and white version, she must move back to the previous Red or space or Start. If the player lands on a Net space, she can cross the net safely. If the player lands on the Shark's Nose space, she must go back to Start.

The first player to reach Safe wins the game.
