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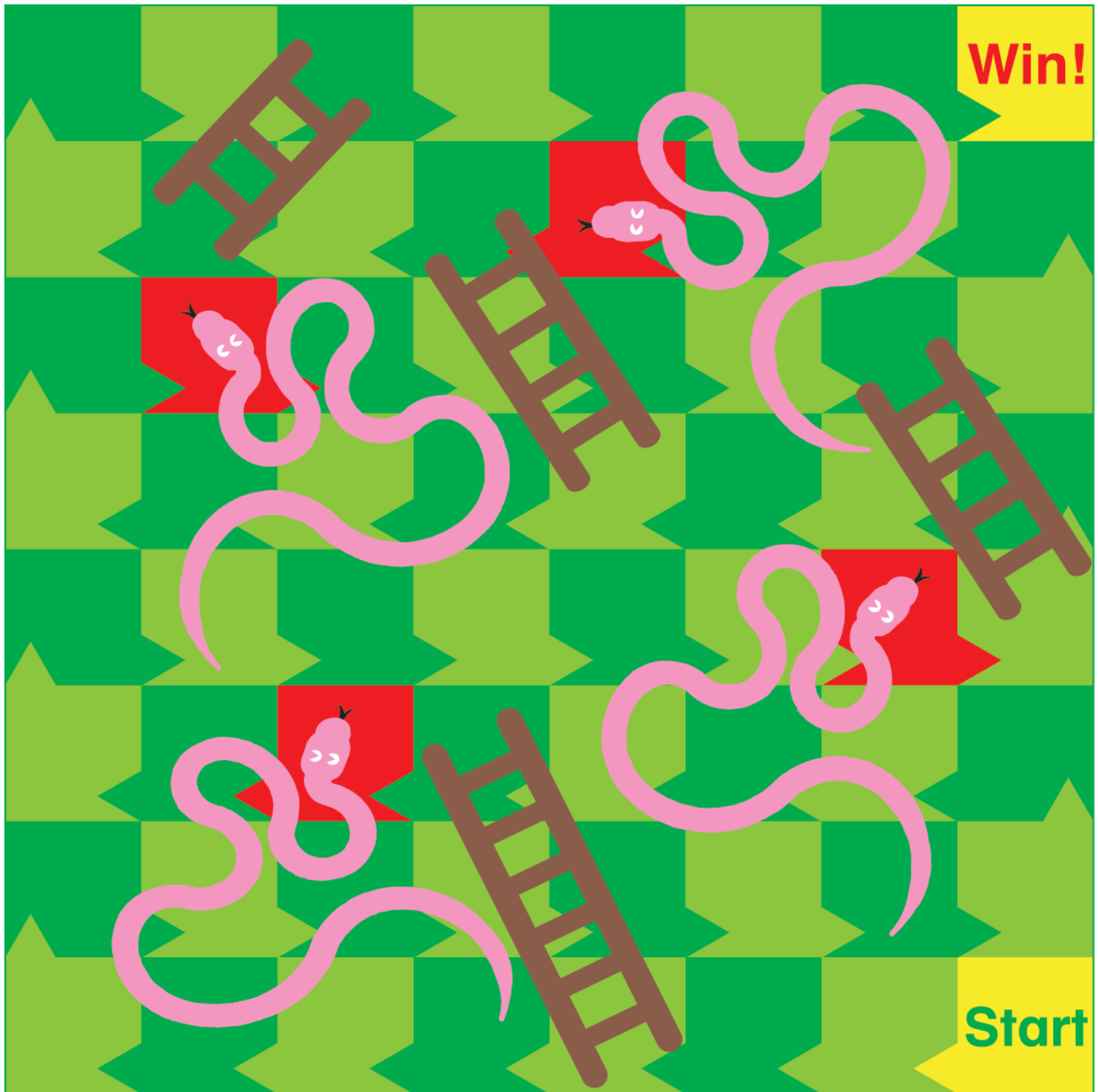

Snakes & Ladders

Snakes & Ladders Instructions

A game for 2-4 players. Snakes & Ladders is a variation of a popular board game normally played with numbers. This is a blank version of the game that teachers can modify to suit the lessons being taught.

Each player throws one or two dice and, counting aloud in English, moves his counter or button following the direction of the arrows.

When a player lands on a snake's head in a red space, he is "swallowed" and must go to the end of the snake's tail. If the player lands at the foot of a ladder, he can go to the top of the ladder.

The first player to reach "Win" wins the game.
